If you're over 65 and sustain a disability, you will not be covered by the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS). If you or a loved one were over 65 when the NDIS was implemented, you were also excluded.

We think this is unfair and want to help change it. Here's what you need to know.

New campaign launched to end age discrimination

It's called "Disability Doesn't Discriminate but the Government does".

In 2013, the Age Discrimination Act was amended to make it lawful for the NDIS to exclude people over of the age of 65.

1. Go to www.disabilitydoesntdiscriminate.com.au and sign up. A letter will be automatically sent to your Federal MP demanding they take a number of steps to give Australians over 65 access to the same level of funding as younger Australians.
